



Maritime Holiday Region One Caravan

Gaspé to Prince Edward Island

August 5-17, 2008

Caravan Itinerary

- **August 5** Rendezvous by 3PM in Cumberland, Maine at the Cumberland County Fairgrounds. Easy to get to from the highway. We will hold our first driver's meeting here outside. All back-in parking with 15-20 amp and water. Dump station.
- **August 6** 102 miles: Leave sometime before 10AM for the (highway) ride up to Palmyra Golf & RV Resort in Palmyra, Maine. Back-in parking with WES.
- **August 7** 195 miles: Leave sometime before 9AM for the (highway) ride up to Presque Isle, Maine to Arndt's Aroostook River Lodge & CG. Back-in parking with 30amp & water. Dump station.
- **August 8** 137 miles: Leave sometime before 9AM, (mostly good secondary roads with some highway), cross the border from Van Buren, Maine to Saint-Anne-De-Madawaska, New Brunswick, Canada; travel to Camping Municipal de la Pointe in Rivière du loup, Québec, Canada 15, 20 & 30 Amp & water. Dump station.
- **August 9** 118 miles: Leave before 10AM (mostly good secondary roads), and travel along the Ste. Lawrence River to Camping Parc Sirois La Baleine just west of Mâtine. They have a good facility here for a BBQ and mostly side by side hookups with pull-through parking. Some will have to back in, but they are long sites. 30Amp with water and mostly sewer & dump station.
- **August 10** 186 miles: Leave before 9AM (mostly good secondary roads), comprised of hilly terrain overlooking the Ste Lawrence River to Camping Baie de Gaspé which is near the City of Gaspé. WES at most sites and are mostly all pull-thru.
- **August 11** 0 miles: Stay in Gaspé City.
- **August 12** 67 miles; Leave by 10AM (mostly good secondary roads), over hilly terrain overlooking coastal Quebec. Some very pretty scenery on the way to Camping Du Phare A Perce in the small village of Perce. All back-in sites with WES for most.
- **August 13** 0 miles: Stay in Perce.
- **August 14** 118 miles; Leave by 10AM (mostly good secondary roads), over mostly hilly terrain to a seaside campsite in Carleton, Quebec. The campground's name is Camping Carleton. All back-in sites with WES.
- **August 15** 180 miles: Leave by 9AM: Travel along coastal Quebec and some highway back into New Brunswick to a campsite in Saint-Louis-du-Kent, NB. The Campground's name is Municipal Park D'aigle. Parking will be all pull-thru sites with WES.
- **August 16** 0 miles: Stay in Saint-Louis-du-Kent, NB. Caravan Farewell Banquet or Lobster Bake.
- **August 17** 122 miles: Leave by 10AM (mostly good secondary roads), over coastal roads, some congested towns; drive over the Federation Bridge to PEI and along back country roads to the Region One Rally in Oyster Bed Bridge, PEI. WES for some.

The mileage of the trip totals 1,236 miles.
